Steve Holcomb and his "Night Train" Win Olympic Gold

MY FAMILY AND I WENT UP TO VANCOUVER to support our patient Steve Holcomb who is the lead driver for the U.S. Bobsled team at the Winter Olympics in February. Words could not describe the elation we all felt as we watched Steve and his team drive their ominous sled called "Night Train" to the

first U.S. Gold medal in the sport in 62 years! With tears streaming down my eyes, I was hugging everyone in sight...including Steve! Photos at www.BoxerWachler.com and videos are on our YouTube channel that can be found by searching "boxer wachler".

Steve's story is almost unbelievable-3 years ago he was forced to officially retire from the sport due to a degenerative eve disease called Keratoconus. As a result his vision deteriorated to 20/500 and he did not feel safe to drive the bobsled. The U.S. Olympic Committee and U.S. Bobsled and Skeleton Federation along with his coaches, team, and team doctor Scott Stoll didn't want to lose their best driver. He had seen 12 eve doctors who either recommended an invasive cornea transplant or shrugged their shoulders with no solution. That's when they found us at BWVI. I treated Steve with C3-R to strengthen the cornea and 3 months

later I performed Visian ICLs for myopia. Steve regained his eyesight to 20/20 and immediately came out of retirement. The rest is medical and Olympic history!

One April 26, 2010, I honored Steve by officially renaming C3-R as "Holcomb C3-R". This marks the first time that a treatment for a disease was named after the Olympic athlete who made it world famous. Steve's story has inspired millions of people around the world as everyone faces challenges of one kind or another in life. Steve's story is the ultimate story of triumph over adversity. Statins May Have Adverse Effects on the Eyes

MANY PEOPLE TAKE prescription drugs in the class called "statins" (such as Lipitor) to lower cholesterol. Since statins can cause muscle disorders, it's interesting that a recent study found statins were also associated with eye muscle disorders. Some of these eye muscle problems included: droopy eyelid, loss of range of eye movement and, double vision. The good news is that when patients stopped taking the statin drugs, all the symptoms resolved. Early Research on Stem Cell Therapy for Blindness

HUMAN EMBRYONIC STEM CELLS are showing promise to help those with vision loss from macular degeneration. These stem cells come from fetuses in lieu of adult stem cells that are used for leukemia for example. While there is controversy over the use of embryonic stem cells, research is moving ahead. Once these cells are implanted in various areas of the body, they may be able to reconnect nerves whose connections were lost due to prior trauma or disease. For example Geron, a company based in Menlo Park, California, received approval to start an FDA study using embryonic stem cells to treat patients with with acute spinal cord injury.

In a study of mice with macular degeneration, implanted embryonic stem cells were able to partially restore vision, according to the published study by researchers at University College London and and London's Moorefields Eye Hospital. Recently Advanced Cell Technology (ACT) is seeking to start an FDA trial for implantation of embryonic stem cells into the retina of patients with macular degeneration. While the data on stem cells and macular degeneration is very premature, it is very hopeful and we will provide updates on this exciting area of research.
